


Historical Association List of Speakers

The List of Speakers consists of historians, who are willing to speak at branch meetings – and sometimes at events organised jointly by branches with other local historical societies – on an 'expenses only' basis. This service is greatly valued and enables, often impoverished, branches to offer a range of subjects to anyone who wishes to attend these lectures and increase their knowledge of history.
