Resource Details:

A 12-minute video about 4 types of Stone Age art - animals, portable, symbols, and hand prints. It includes discussion of artists' materials and techniques, and shows images of different art examples from around Europe. Key words are subtitled. The unit is presented live in authentic-looking Stone Age costume and is not a PowerPoint.

Necessary prior learning to complete this:

Video is self-contained, but an introduction to basic Stone Age lifestyles would be helpful.

What does it lead to next?

Children might attempt art projects based on the different examples shown. Stone Age art is a popular topic in primary schools, and could provide a cross curricular link between history and art.

Explanation: How should this resource be used?

It was originally produced as part of a package to accompany an artefact loan box, but can also be used as a stand alone learning unit, either broadcast by the class teacher from school, or downloaded at home as a reference source. The 5 Mbps speed is appropriate for most broadband connections.
